## Jukai Retreat Information Sheet April 28th - 30th

During Jukai retreat, we come together to support those individuals who have committed themselves to receiving the Sixteen Bodhisattva Precepts, as well as nourish our own practices. The retreat ends with the special ceremony of Jukai, in which the entire community witnesses, and participates in, the giving and receiving of the Bodhisattva Precepts. The retreat will consist of zazen, chanting, samu (work practice), and precept study.

Freely given donations (dana) are vital to the functioning of Buddha Eye Temple. There is no set fee for retreats or any dharma activities, but the temple relies on generosity to maintain the community. Donations can be made in the dana bowl in the front entrance room of the temple or through our website.

## **Attending Part Time:**

- -If you would like to join us part time, the morning and evening blocks do not require registration and are open for drop-in participation.
- -The morning block is 5:00am 7:20am and the evening block is from 6:45pm 9:15pm. For these blocks, simply come to those you are able to attend. We encourage you to attend the entirety of the block.

## Attending Full Time:

-Due to the nature of this retreat, for any full time participation there is only the option to attend the entirety of the retreat. Registration is required.

Start: Friday at 5am

Ends: Sunday after clean-up and bow-out following the Jukai ceremony.

-Please fill out the entirety of the registration sheet and place it in the "Completed Registration" folder. If this is your first time participating in a full-day of a Buddha Eye retreat, the retreat leader will contact you prior to the start of retreat to schedule a short conversation.
